In May 2019 you elected two Greens, Clare Sutton and Brian Heatley – who is leaving Weymouth with his wife Nicky to be closer to family in London, and will be greatly missed. Brian and Clare have helped residents with a huge range of issues and played key roles in several local campaigns, including fighting FOR reopening the **Underbarn Walk** and AGAINST the



Portland Waste Incinerator. The Green Group has also made a big impact on Dorset Council, including:

- Proposing a motion committing Dorset Council to working with central government and water companies to **clean up our water**, which was passed with cross party support
- Playing a central role in securing more funding for **Dorset's Youth Clubs**


